This year's theme is Compassion. The week is a time to honor refugees and appreciate the contributions, creativity, and resilience of refugees and people seeking sanctuary.



Refugee Sunday

This Sunday toiletry goods or cash donations to our Circuit Project are most welcome. Rev Dan Woodhouse is preaching and we welcome our guest speaker, Maude Casey from the Migrant English Project, Thousand for Thousand (T4K). T4K is a local charity whose aim is to be a community response to enforced homelessness amongst forced migrants. T4K pools small donations from hundreds of people to provide housing and other support to migrants in Brighton & Hove who would otherwise be destitute. They work very closely with the Jollof Cafe and the Sussex Refugee and Migrant Self Support group. Maude will talk about her daily work supporting Sanctuary seeking people in Brighton and Hove.
