


World AIDS Day Service of Remembrance and Hope

Home front Update from Uganda

I've not been to anywhere in Africa before, so this week has been quite an experience as I find myself immersed in a very different way of life. Firstly, though, the traffic! I thought Portland Road was full of unpredictable drivers, but nothing could have prepared me for my first



taste of life in Kampala. Motorbikes everywhere, three or four abreast in a constant stream, or maybe behind you on the pavement or coming from the wrong way. The first puzzle was "How do we cross the road?" Fortunately, a kindly local showed us, and we followed her lead - it seems you walk and hope for the best! Confidence is key.

It's also such a friendly place. The school is lovely, in a small village, and the children are delightful. Every day starts with devotions the children (aged between 3 and 14) lead. After the singing and a prayer, they have classes. After lunch, they finish with more worship songs and a prayer and then knock a few mangoes from the tree for a home-time snack. Besides crossing the road, my biggest challenge has been learning all the children's names. After a week, I'm starting to get there.
