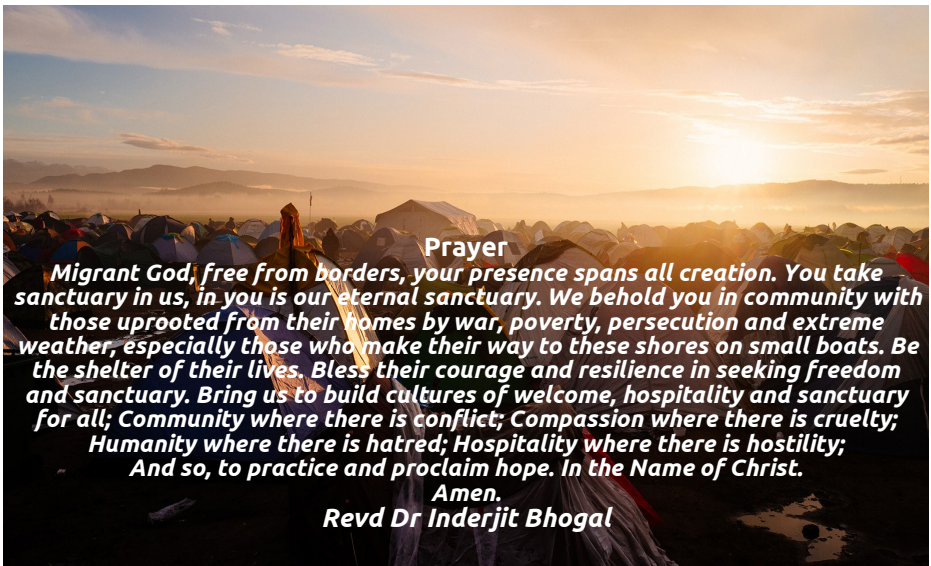

Circuit Refugee Project

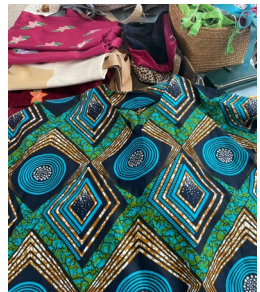
