This is one 'not to be missed' on the HMC calendar for sure!

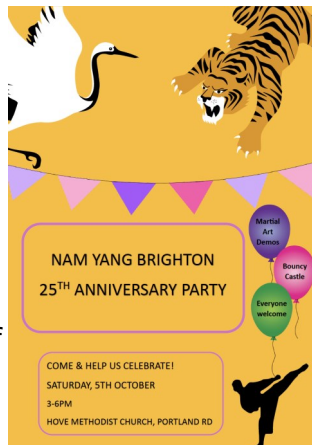
