Boiler Issues

As you may already be aware, the boiler responsible for heating most areas of our building has broken down. However, the boiler for the sanctuary is still functioning.

We have made enquiries about repairs and have been informed that a purpose-built replacement will be required. Unfortunately, it is unlikely that this replacement will be available before the end of January 2025, due to the holiday break and the time needed to order parts.

We apologise that we are unable to give you an exact date but in the mean time we have secured and are ordering more alternative sources of heating in the form of space heaters. While we understand this will not provide immediate warmth, we encourage you to turn them on before you begin. Additionally, we are happy to move activities to the sanctuary (main church) if preferred, as it has heating available.
