

Most of you are aware of the problems with the boiler which developed just before Christmas. The Treasurer has been seeking advice regarding the replacement together with quotes for the work. Three companies have been approached for quotes resulting in the proposal to replace the existing 215kW boiler with two smaller boilers in a cascade system. The new boiler will be of the condensing type and will need the chimney flue lining. This is a specialist job.
